## Measuring the impact of investment portfolios

Banks and asset managers see themselves confronted with the growing expectation of their clients to provide transparency on the impact of investments. This does not only apply to classic impact investing, where impact measurement has always been an important requirement but increasingly to sustainable investments in liquid asset classes too.

But is it possible to demonstrate the impact of a sustainable equity or bond portfolio? And which reporting methods and KPIs are being developed internationally to demonstrate the influence of investments on the world?

In this workshop, SSF would like to give participants the opportunity to learn, from both an academic and a practical perspective, about how the impact of sustainable investments can be measured. The inputs form the basis for a subsequent discussion and exchange of experiences among the participants on practical ways to demonstrate the impact of their investments.
