
How to search for a publication using filters

You can search for publications using different filters. SSF has classified each publication according to theme and report type. The filters allow you to narrow down your search. Apply a filter by selecting the relevant tags, clicking "Save", and pressing the "Filter" button.

Please note that choosing additional filter criteria expands your search. For example selecting "ESG Integration" and "Performance" will give you all publications marked with either of the two tags or with both.





The report shows that Switzerland has already firmly established the UN's Sustainable Development Goals in its policies, although challenges still remain. It is in Switzerland's interests to contribute to the financing of sustainable development – through its official development assistance, but increasingly through strategic partnerships and the mobilisation of private resources for sustainable development.
